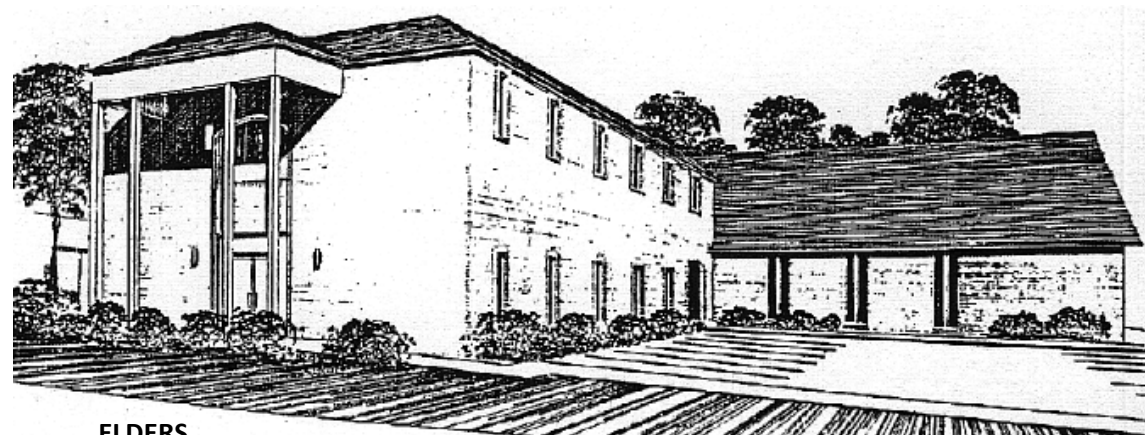
Landon's Letters
